Items not included: Firearms permit US \$120, rifle hire if needed US \$100 (plus ammo), airfares, before and after hunt expenses (hotel expenses during travel), gratuities, packing and shipping, hard liquor, and personal expenses. Skinning for a full body mount for Buffalo and Banteng \$1000.
